ABSTRACT SUBMISSION CHECKLIST

Abstract Elements

- Title of your presentation (limited to 85 characters)
- Industry division and track (core or focuses), from those listed above, to which your presentation topic is most applicable
- Identify if presentation is Technical Session, Panel or Training
- Short abstract of the proposed presentation (limited to 300 words), which includes:
 - How the topic is currently relevant to the industry
 - What objectives you will cover during the session
 - The intended/target audience (e.g., inspectors, engineers, managers, etc.)
 - Brief speaker biography with no more than 100 words that details your qualifications to speak on the subject
 - Note, if there are more than one author, please identify the primary contact for the presentation
 - Target level of presentation content (introductory, intermediate, or advanced)
