ARTS & CULTURE

Denver Art Museum | 100 W 14th Ave. Pkwy

First opened in 1971, the fortress-like structure was designed by Italian architect Gio Ponti and Denver-based James Sudler Associates. The building has been fully renovated with expanded gallery space, plus stunning views of the city skyline and Rocky Mountains. The building showcases Asian art, Indigenous arts of North America, Northwest Coast and Alaska Native, European and American art before 1900, Latin American and art of the ancient Americas, photography, textile art and fashion, and Western American art collections. Murals & Street Art

One of the best museums in Denver is the city itself. Denver street artists have been busy brightening (and enlightening) the urban landscape for decades by making canvases of the city's alleyways, building exteriors, warehouses, garage doors and storefronts. DOWNTOWN DENVER

Denver Union Station

This landmark has undergone a massive restoration that transformed it into a transportation, dining, shopping, and entertainment hub, and hotel. The historic, Beaux-Arts 1914 train terminal is now a foodie destination, with a dozen restaurants and bars, from farm-to-table favorite Mercantile dining + provision to the Terminal Bar, situated in the station's old ticket windows. A handful of local retailers includes a branch of the popular Tattered Cover Book Store. Union Station is also fulfilling its original role as a major ground transportation hub, serving as an Amtrak, light rail, and shuttle bus station with direct rail service to DIA.

Larimer Square

Victorian buildings house specialty boutiques and unique chef-driven restaurants with one-of-a-kind stores and distinctive fashion and exclusive offerings in this urban shopping and dining district.

RiNo District

Located just a mile north of downtown, the River North Art District – or RiNo for short – is Denver's creative hub. Home to artisans, painters, photographers, designers, filmmakers, and architects, RiNO combines the city's most progressive exhibition spaces with the city's coolest live/work spaces. RiNO is "Where Art is Made."

SURROUNDING AREAS

Boulder

Distance from Denver: 30 miles

Boulder is a vibrant city nestled in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains. Stroll down the sunny Pearl Street Mall, a four-block pedestrian mall lined with coffee shops, stores and restaurants and dotted with street performers. Hike along the Boulder Creek Path or through Chautauqua Park, a National Historic Landmark, then grab a beer at one of the many craft breweries in town. There are also numerous museums, theaters, music venues, and more!

Central City & Black Hawk

Distance from Denver: 40 miles

Central City and Black Hawk are home to more than 30 casinos with blackjack tables, craps, roulette, poker games, and more than 10,000 slot machines. In 2009, gambling stake were raised to \$100, to the delight of high rollers, and casinos began opening their doors 24 hours a day. The two cities are also known for having some of the best-preserved Victorian architecture in the West.

Echo Lake & Mount Blue Sky Scenic Byway

Distance from Denver: 60 miles

Mount Blue Sky Scenic Byway is the highest paved auto road in North America, snaking its way to the 14,260-foot summit. Online reservations are now required for timed slots. The road is open only from Memorial Day through Labor Day, and frequently has snow on it, even in August. The view for the top takes in the entire Front Range. The summit is 60 miles from downtown Denver. On your way up to the mountain, be sure to stop at M. Walter Pesman Trail (maintained by Denver Botanic Gardens) for a wildflower hike; you won't see anything like the rare flowers and 1,500-year-old bristlecone pine trees anywhere else in the world. The

Garden of the Gods

Distance from Denver: 58 miles

Garden of the Gods is one of Colorado's most epic natural wonders, featuring striking geological formations at near 90-degree angles. Some activities and features include guided nature walks, hiking, mountain biking and horseback riding trails, road biking, and technical rock climbing.

Georgetown Loop Railroad


Distance from Denver: 54 miles

The Georgetown Loop Railroad is a reconstruction of one of Colorado's most famous railroads, which was originally built in 1877. Steam-powered locomotives make the climb up the valley and across Devil's Gate Bridge, giving riders panoramic views and a glimpse into Colorado's railroad-centric past. From the open-air viewing cars, it is possible to see bighorn sheep and other wildlife.

Rocky Mountain National Park

Distance from Denver: 71 miles

One of the U.S. National Park System's crown jewels, Rocky Mountain National Park features 400 square miles of scenic beauty, including Trail Ridge Road, the highest continuous highway in the world, crossing the Continental Divide at more than two miles above sea level. With hundreds of miles of hiking trails, tranquil lakes, waterfalls, wildlife and horseback riding visiting the Park is truly an unforgettable experience. Estes Park is a resort town on the edge of the Park with restaurants and shops.

The Boettcher Memorial Tropical Conservatory is the largest single structure tropical conservatory in the U.S., including banyan tree roots and cloud forest orchids.
